BACKGROUND:	any person	<i>cipal Act</i> states that Council may, upon the application of n, authorize minor variances from the Sign By-law if in the Council the general intent and purpose of the By-law is d.
COMMENTS :	The Planning and Building Department has received three (3)Sign Variance Applications (see Appendices 1 to 3) for approval by Council. Each application is accompanied by a summary page prepared by the Planning and Building Department which includes information pertaining to the site location; the applicant's proposal; the variance required; an assessment of the merits (or otherwise) of the application; and a recommendation on whether the variance should or should not be granted.	
FINANCIAL IMPACT:	Not applic	cable.

CONCLUSION:	Council may authorize minor variances from Sign By-law 0054-2002, as amended, if in the opinion of Council, the general intent and purpose of the By-law is maintained. Sign By-law 0054-2002, as amended, was passed pursuant to the <i>Municipal Act</i> . In this respect, there is no process to appeal the decision of Council to the Ontario Municipal Board, as in a development application under the <i>Planning Act</i> .

COMMENTS:

The proposed variance is for a fascia sign on the north elevation of the building facing Dundas Street East. There are two other fascia signs on the east and west sides of the tower feature already approved. The proposed sign is also located on a tower feature of the building and is in keeping with the design of the building. The Planning and Building Department therefore finds the proposed variance acceptable from a design perspective.

We are asking for relief from the provisions of the City of Mississauga Sign By-law 54-02 to install appropriate and distinctive signage for the Monte Carlo Inn as follows:


- 1. To permit a fascia sign on the North elevation of the existing Monte Carlo Inn hotel located at 1886 Dundas Street East. This sign is proposed at 75 square feet and is 4% of the wall space (whereas 2% is the maximum allowed under the current sign by-law).
- 2. To permit an additional sign on the West elevation which will be under the maximum 2% allowed for a sign.

The signs will conform to the standard Monte Carlo Inn signage at the other locations and will be the only signs on the North and West walls.


We feel the requested signage falls within the intent of the By-law and will not have a negative impact on the streetscape, therefore, we respectfully ask for your consideration in the matter.



The applicant requests the following variance to section 13 of the Sign By-law 0054-2002, as amended.

COMMENTS:

The proposed variance is for two (2) fascia signs at the upper limits of the top storey of a seven storey office building in the Cooksville District Plan. Sign By-law 54-2002 defines this district as a Special Character Area and provides specific signage requirements.

If the office building was located in another part of Mississauga other than a Special Character Area, the proposed variance would be permitted. In the development of the signage provisions for the Special Character Areas, multi-storey office buildings were not addressed. In this regard, this variance would have to be evaluated on its own design merit.

The proposed signs are non-illuminated individual lettering, located between the windows of the top storey of the building and the roof. The signs are proportional to the façade space in which they are proposed to be located. The Planning and Building Department therefore finds the variance acceptable from a design perspective.

WEST ELEVATION - PROPOSED


